Something to Consider

Lead your group through a discussion using the following questions.

1. Is your group Me-Centered, We-Centered, Them-Centered?
2. What's the BIG IDEA for your group?
3. How will your group connect with people where they live, work, learn, play and at their point of need?
4. Who are you praying you will have the opportunity to introduce to Jesus this week?
5. What areas of ministry within your group need leadership?

Something to Pray

You may have already had your group prayer time or you may be about to begin. Either way, add the following things to your prayer list and ask someone to voice a prayer for these things out loud.

READ, Romans 1:15 and 2 Timothy 4:5

1. **ME**—Ask God to make you ready to share the gospel.
2. **WE**—Ask God to allow our group to fulfill its ministry.
3. **THEM**—Pray for friends and family who need to hear the gospel by name.

Something to Do

Nothing draws people together like a goal to reach, a game to win or a project to accomplish. Continue to give your group small, achievable goals to reach.

1. ***INVITE WEEK***—select a specific week in the future and encourage members of your group to invite friends to attend that day.
2. ***FELLOWSHIP***—plan another fellowship to coincide with Invite Week. Encourage your group to bring the friends they will invite into your group to that fellowship!
3. ***3 MONTH CHECK UP***—3 months from now evaluate you Big Idea, your group leadership structure and how you are doing at following through.
4. ***CHALLENGE***—Every member of your group to read Scripture daily and memorize Romans 1:15.
